

ENTERING CHILE

Requirements FOR NON-RESIDENT FOREIGNERS entering Chile

- ✓ Proof of a negative PCR test taken 72 hours before boarding. On flights with layovers, the last boarding point is considered.
- ✓ Complete the “Traveler’s Sworn Statement” electronic form up to 48 hours before boarding, in which you must provide your contact information, health and location history. This form will include a QR code as a means of verification. It can be completed at <https://www.c19.cl/en.html> (English version).
- ✓ You will have to stay 5 days under quarantine in a transit hotel, where a new PCR test will be performed. If test is negative, you will be able to continue your 10-day quarantine period at your final destination and if test is positive, you will be transferred to a health residence. During the first 14 days after entering the country a follow-up form will be required which will be sent to your e-mail on a daily basis. Timely completion is mandatory.
- ✓ On the **official website** chile.travel/planviajarachile, which is also available in English, you will find detailed information on the requirements for entering Chile, onward travel within the country and additional information in the form of a question-and-answer catalogue.

PCR TEST STATIONS

- PCRs for travellers do not require a medical order.
- Nasal swab PCR
- There are test centers offering the PCR test service at the client's location "servicio a domicilio"
- The appointment for a PCR test is mainly made via web, phone or Whatsapp and it takes place at the client's location on the next working day.
- The cost for the PCR test including the above mentioned service is around CLP 50,000 (USD 68,-)
- The time it takes for results to be available ranges from 24 to 72 hours.

- Only offering antigen and antibody testing in Puerto Natales and can be done at home, but not offering PCR tests
- **NOTE** that if entering across the border, it must be at Puerto Natales, which is closer than Punta Arenas.
- There is only the mobile truck that is organised through the Cesfam and the municipality of Natales and that is placed in certain places on certain days and there they offer the PCR test.
