

# ENTRY TO CHILE

## BEFORE TRAVELLING

### 1 Have your vaccination certificate at hand

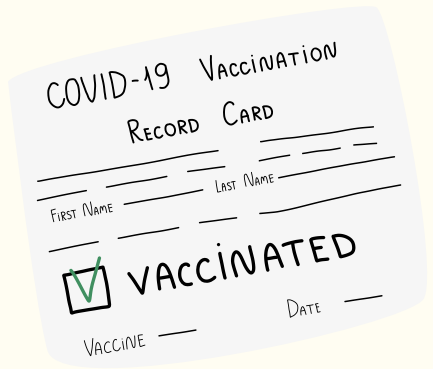


You can enter with the Vaccination Certificate issued by your country (either printed or in digital version) in addition to your Identity Document.

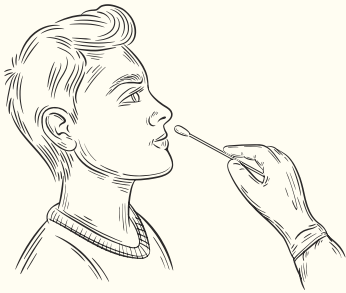
The Vaccination Certificate presented will be equivalent to the Mobility Pass which is necessary for inter-regional travel and access to some public places (restaurants, museums, hotels).

**NOTE:**

Non-vaccinated persons must present a negative PCR test taken no more than 48 hours before the flight departure to Chile.



## IN CHILE



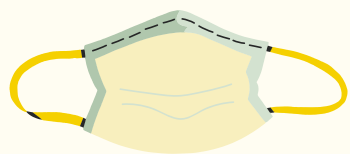
### 2 PCR Test at airport

The PCR test is carried out randomly and those who are selected will not be obliged to undergo travel quarantine. However, if the result of the test is positive, isolation for 7 days is compulsory.

### 3 Face mask



The use of a face mask is no longer mandatory in open spaces (keeping social distancing of at least 1 metre). However, the use of it is still necessary inside all enclosed public places.



## RECOMMENDATIONS



Not mandatory, but recommended :

Travel medical insurance



### Use digital SAG affidavit

Do not bring prohibited products into Chile. Declare digitally before starting your trip (suggested in case you won't have internet connection) and enter with QR code or in [ingresoachile.cl](https://ingresoachile.cl)



### Travelling with Smartphone recommended

Many services in Chile are operated digitally with the use of QR codes and email, such as menus in restaurants, tickets to national parks, airline boarding passes, ...
