

MASS VACCINATION PLAN BEGINS IN CHILE



On the 3rd of February 2021 a massive inoculation process began in Chile against COVID-19 after the arrival of the first two million doses of the Sinovac vaccine, for which a "vaccination schedule" will be used. As reported by the head of state, a second plane with another two million inoculations has already arrived in the country, being in a position to advance the "ambitious" plan to stop the pandemic.

The Chilean vaccination plan is being carried out with almost four million vaccines from the Chinese laboratory Sinovac, which already arrived on two flights and more vaccines will continue to arrive gradually in the coming weeks. According to the calendar presented by the Chilean government, they hope to vaccinate five million people during the first quarter of this year, to get 15 million inoculated by mid-2021.

WHO WILL BE THE FIRST ONES TO GET VACCINATED

The Head of State explained that the vaccination process will have the following order:

- Health workers who work with the most critical patients in ICUs
- Adults over 80 years of age
- Residents in the ELEAM and Sename
- Workers essential for the proper functioning of the State and society
- Adults between 65 and 80 years old and chronically ill
- Education workers
- Essential basic services
- Rest of the population
