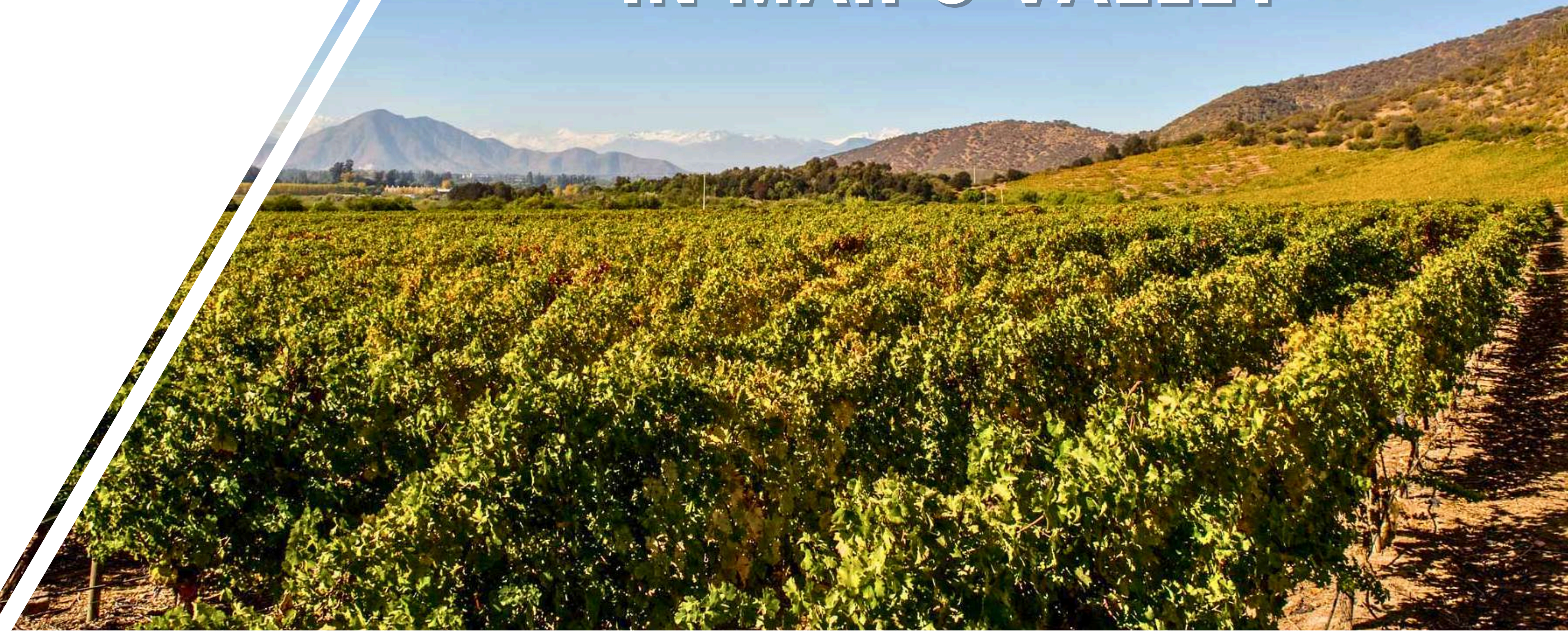

HARAS DE PIRQUE

VINEYARD

Haras de Pirque's horseshoe-shaped design reflects its passion for thoroughbred horses and the nearby farm.

Built on a hillside, the winery uses gravity flow technology to gently process grapes, reducing the need for motor pumps. This method prevents oxidation, preserves aromas, softens tannins, and enhances wine quality while minimizing energy use.





PEREZ CRUZ

The modern facilities of Perez Cruz are situated at the foot of the Andes, about 45 kilometers from Santiago. The vineyard covers 230 hectares, primarily planted with Cabernet Sauvignon (80%) along with various Bordeaux varieties.

Architect José Cruz Ovalle designed over 7,000 m² of laminated wood structures that meet the technical requirements for fine winemaking while harmonizing with the natural landscape.





SANTA RITA VINEYARD

Founded in 1880, Santa Rita Vineyard has refined its winemaking expertise, ensuring timeless quality that captivates wine lovers worldwide.

CLOS APALTA

MONTES VINEYARD

Opened in December 2004, the Montes vineyard in Colchagua Valley has a 2.3-million-liter capacity, enhancing production of acclaimed reds like Montes Alpha, Montes Alpha M, Montes Folly, and Purple Angel.

One of Chile's most advanced wineries, it integrates harmoniously with the Coastal Mountains, offering panoramic views and a Feng Shui-inspired design.





SANTA CRUZ VINEYARD

Santa Cruz Vineyard captures the essence of Colchagua Valley with its rich history, traditions, and unique adventures. A highlight is the cable car ride to Cerro Chamán hill, where visitors can explore villages representing Chile's three indigenous peoples: Mapuche, Rapa Nui, and Aymara. These cultures, along with their gods Machi and Chaman, inspire the vineyard's wines.

Another wonderful experience is a visit to the wine and automobile museum.
